



ANJI WOODLEY

Anji Woodley is a South African multidisciplinary artist based in Toronto, Canada, with a growing presence across international exhibitions in Canada, the United States, and Mexico. Working across painting, sculpture, and immersive installation, she grounds her practice in an experimental approach to materials and form.

Rooted in South Africa, within a creatively rich and storytelling-driven environment, narrative remains central to her work. This foundation continues to inform a practice that explores how stories are carried, transformed, and shared across time and place.

Her work centers on states of consciousness and the idea that we exist interconnected as wavelengths, thought, and perception.

Through recurring portal-like forms that appear across both two-dimensional and sculptural works, she creates visual thresholds that suggest movement between inner and outer worlds, the seen and unseen, the individual and the collective.

In December 2025, Anji Woodley did an Artist Residency at Alejandra Topete Gallery. During the residency, she explored manipulating canvas with clay, blending textile and ceramic elements to create a sculptural, woven wall piece. This work investigates the visual language of brain wavelengths and how they shift across different states of consciousness.
