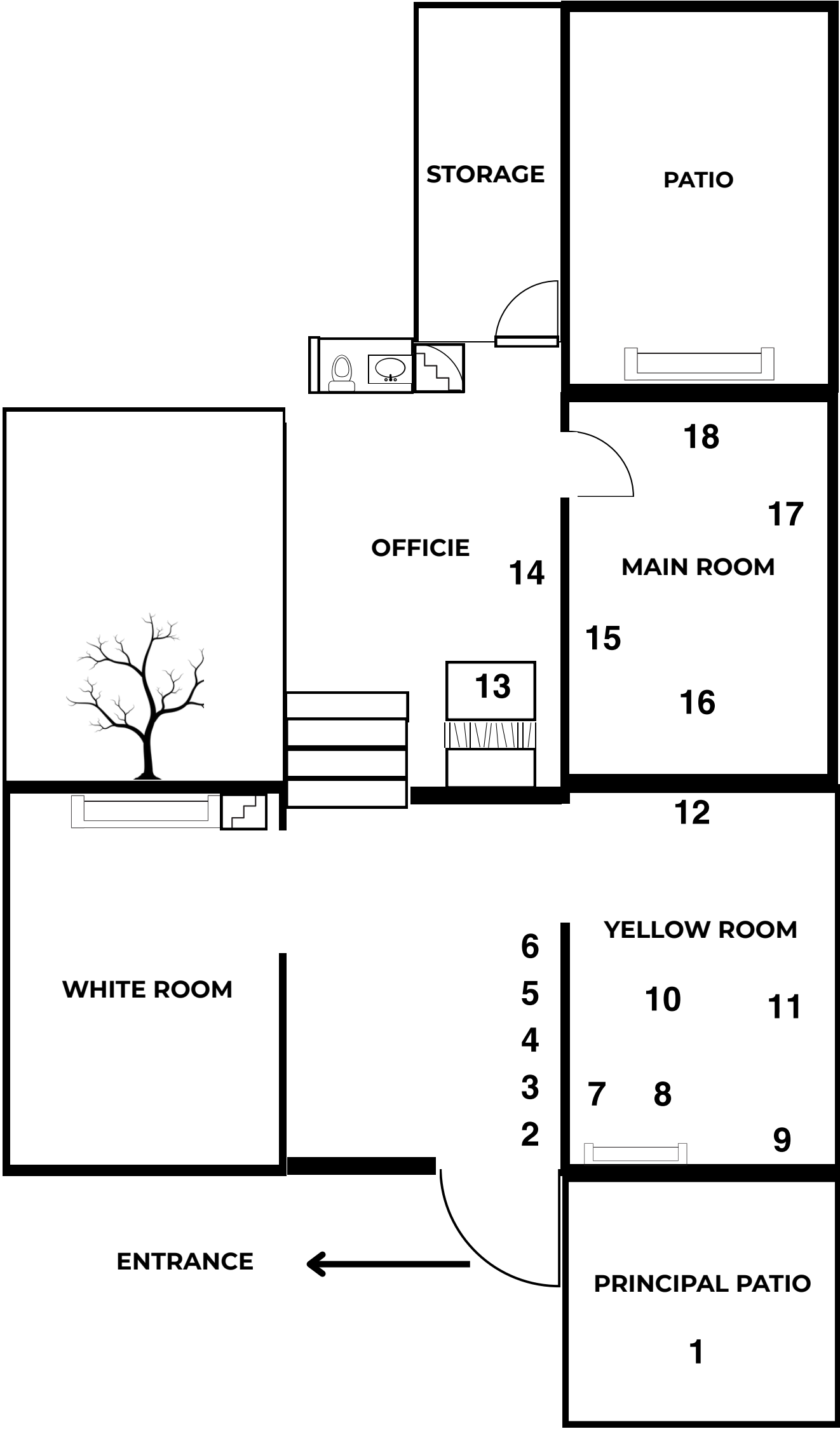


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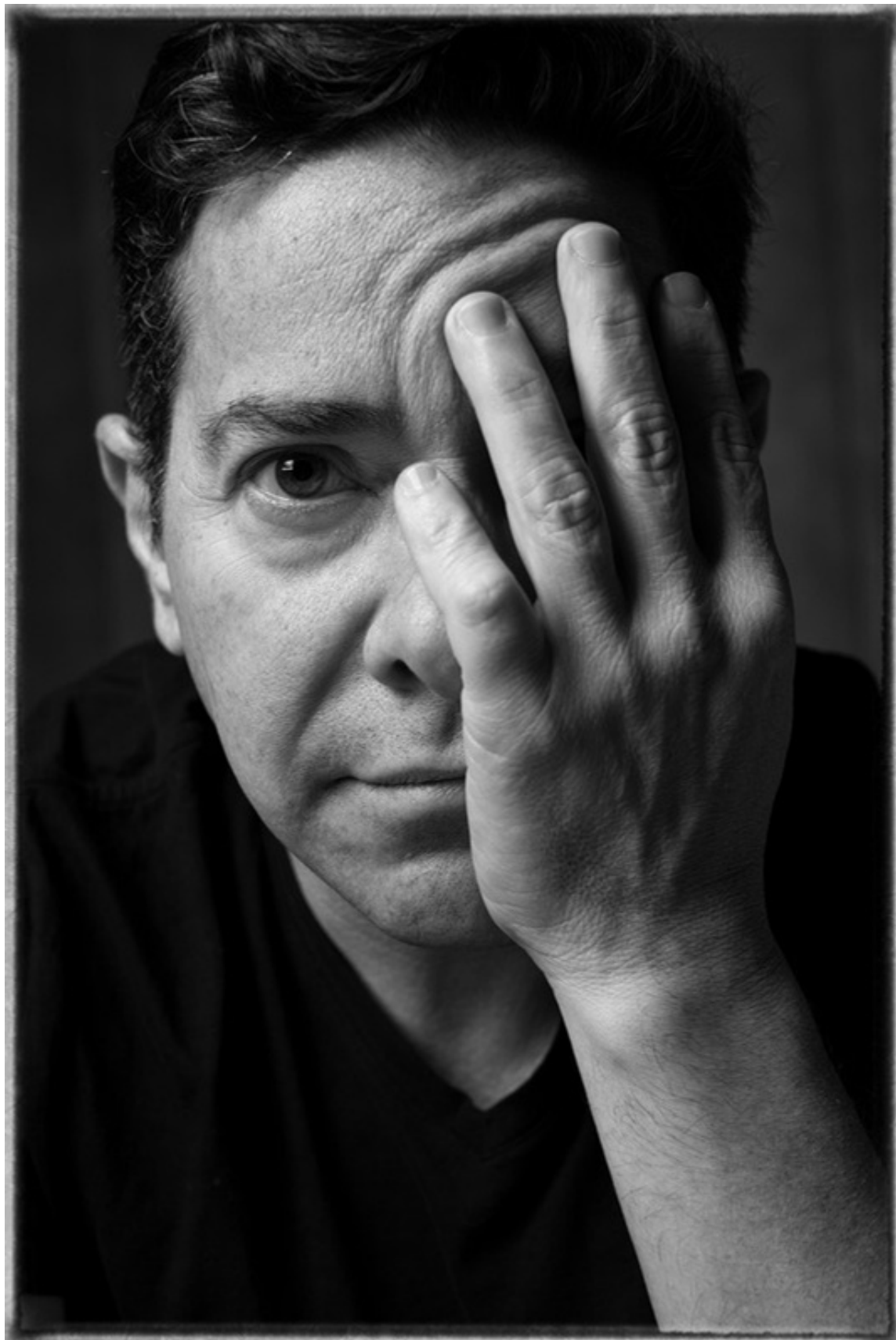

Gaber has developed his vocation through self-study, as well as under the tutelage of various teachers in Mexico, and through assistantships in workshops led by recognized artists. His most recent courses include the Talleres del Prado in Madrid and the Royal College of Art in London.

William Gaber's work encompasses a range of media, including painting, drawing, ready-made objects, sculpture, and digital art. The choice and diversity of media in his language are integral to his identity as an artist, not driven by whim or chance, but positioning him as an artist of his time and a keen, ingenious observer of reality.
